Collection of Data: The feedback is collected manually by circulating the feedback forms.






From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (70%) agreed, Students (30%) strongly agreed and students (0%) are disagreed.

2. Library and reading facility.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (55%) agreed, Students (40%) strongly agreed and students (05%) are disagreed.

3. Washroom facility/Drinking water facility.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (65%) Agreed, Students (30%) strongly agreed and students (05%) are disagreed.

4. Guidance/counselling in academic and non-academic Matters.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (55%) agreed, Students (40%) strongly agreed and students (05%) are disagreed.



5. Participation and discussion in class


From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (50%) Agreed, Students (44%) strongly agreed and students (06%) are disagreed.

6. Canteen facility




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (50%) Agreed, Students (38%) strongly agreed and students (12%) are disagreed.
