Collection of Data: The feedback is collected manually by circulating the feedback forms.





From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (40%)


agreed, Students (60%) strongly agreed and students (00%) are disagreed.

2. Recognition/incentive/appreciation of the individual work is given.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (35%) agreed, Students (65%) strongly agreed and students (00%) are disagreed.

3. The Principal is approachable and assessable and believe in continuous development of the staff.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (29%) agreed, Students (71%) strongly agreed and students (00%) are disagreed.

4. The college provides full freedom to adopt new techniques/strategies of teaching.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (24%) agreed, Students (76%) strongly agreed and students (00%) are disagreed.
