Collection of Data: The feedback is collected manually by circulating the feedback forms.





1. Admission Procedure.





2. Academic Environment.





3. Infra structure & Lab facilities.





4. Library resources.





5. Canteen Facilities.





7. How do you rate the courses that you have studied for Masters.




