**Analysis and Interpretation:** The data is analyzed through percentages. Charts and diagrams are prepared for easy understanding by using Microsoft Excel.






From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (40%) agreed, Students (60%) strongly agreed and students (00%) are disagreed.

2. The College provides equal opportunities to all staff members




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (80%) Agreed, Students (19%) strongly agreed and students (01%) are disagreed.

3. Recognition/incentive/appreciation of the individual work is given.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (70%) agreed, Students (30%) strongly agreed and students (00%) are disagreed.

4. Capabilities/potential of the staff is fully utilized.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (05%) agreed, Students (95%) strongly agreed and students (00%) are disagreed.

5. Staff is appropriately represented in the governing body.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (21%) agreed, Students (79%) strongly agreed and students (00%) are disagreed.

6. The Principal is approachable and assessable and believe in continuous development of the staff.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (13%) agreed, Students (87%) strongly agreed and students (00%) are disagreed.

7. The college provides full freedom to adopt new techniques/strategies of teaching.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (25%) agreed, Students (75%) strongly agreed and students (00%) are disagreed.

8. The college has good infrastructural facilities as: Library, Laboratories, Rest Room and Medical facilities etc.




From the above feedback analysis, we conclude that majority of the students (29%) agreed, Students (70%) strongly agreed and students (01%) are disagreed.
